



Youth & College Pastor Job Description

Desired Qualifications: Candidates for this position must have made a personal commitment to Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and must demonstrate the reality of that relationship through their life and testimony.

Overview: This is a part-time position to develop and maintain strategies that will allow Canyon Creek Baptist Church to minister to middle school, high school, and college students in a way that glorifies God, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.

Duties:

- Establish annual goals, objectives, and plans to implement.
- Plan and oversee all youth and college activities and programs with a primary focus on Wednesday night activities. This will also apply to retreats, mission trips, summer camp, and other special events.
- Establish a friendly rapport with and among the students through a variety of fun and purposeful activities.
- Develop and promote biblically-based education through Sunday School and other programs.
- Encourage the youth to get involved in the church and provide them opportunities to do so.
- Provide spiritual guidance and counseling to youth as called upon. Give ongoing opportunities to hear the gospel message, opportunities for discipleship, and opportunities to assist them to become spiritually mature Christians.
- Recruit, train, and oversee youth staff (including interns).
- Maintain open communication with church staff, parents, and students.
- Attend scheduled staff meetings.
- Other duties assigned by the Senior Pastor.

Requirements:

- Must be willing to join Canyon Creek Baptist Church as a member.
- Must be a born again and baptized believer.
- Must be a good Christian role model. References will be requested.
- Must be willing to undergo a mandatory background check.
- Shall perform the duties of this position while submitting to the leadership of the Senior Pastor.
