"Five Kinds Of Hearts" Instructions for Counselors

Take one child at a time, generally men with boys and ladies with girls and sit in the floor.

- 1. NEATLY Fill in the top part of the card. (Use this to allow the child to get comfortable with you.)
- 2. Say, "Of the five kinds of hearts the pastor just explained, what kind of a heart do you have?" (Pure, Sad but waiting, Sad and ready, New, Messy)

If the child is not sure, they probably have a pure heart, but you can help them by looking at the posters again, and or by asking the following questions about sin, stopping if they are unsure of what sin is or unaware of sin in their own life:


- What is sin? Do you have any sin in your life?
- Do you ever feel far from God because of sin in your life?
- Right now would you like to ask Jesus to come into your life and forgive your sin and save you?
- 3. Mark the kind of heart the child believes he/she has on the card and pray for the child. If he/she has a "New" heart or "Messy" heart, ask "When did you get a new heart?" Fill in the blank beside "When Did You Get a New Heart?" Then ask, "Have you been baptized since getting a new heart?"
- 4. If the child has a heart that is "sad and ready" then use the salvation prayer on the back of the card and let them repeat the prayer after you.

 ***Write "TODAY" beside "When did you get a new heart?"
- 5. Print your name as Counselor.
- 6. Give the Child a "What Kind of Heart Do You Have" page; and encourage them to tell someone at home about it. They can put their name and date on their kind of heart.
- 7. Turn in the Card; introduce the child to the pastor/counselor leader and let the child tell him/her what kind of heart he/she has now.
